



## *2011 Philip Trammell Shutze Awards Submission*

### **Program Criteria**

The Southeast Chapter is pleased to announce the fifth annual design competition to recognize excellence in Classical and Traditional design. The Shutze Awards will be considered for small, large, and multi-family Residential design and Commercial / Civic / Institutional Projects. Additional awards will be considered for Interior design, Craftsmanship, Renovation, and Landscape / Garden Design. The awards jury includes Gary L. Brewer, Jury Chair, Partner, Robert A. M. Stern Architects; Lindsay Bierman, Deputy Editor of *Southern Living*; and David Brussat, architecture critic of The Providence Journal in Rhode Island. ### **Award Criteria**

The awards are named for Philip Trammell Shutze, the Atlanta architect whose work is revered internationally as one of the 20<sup>th</sup>-century's most devoted classicists. The awards will recognize similar individuals who are contributing to the creation of 21<sup>st</sup>-century Classical and Traditional architecture and related fields.

### **Eligibility**

The work of members of the Southeast Chapter of ICA&CA with offices in the member states of Alabama, Mississippi or Georgia is eligible for consideration. (Individuals and firms in those states may join the SE Chapter at any time by visiting [www.classicist.org](http://www.classicist.org).) The projects may be from any location. The individual making the submission must have the legal right to submit the work of the architects and designers. A member must make the submission and one can join the ICA&CA at the time of submission (see [www.classicist.org](http://www.classicist.org)). Since we are seeking current work, the submission must have been created within the last 10 years. The most recent projects that will be considered must be substantially complete as of submission date of November 29, 2010.

### **Winners**

Winners of the Shutze awards will be recognized at an evening ceremony held on February 12, 2011 at Piedmont Driving Club – one of Philip Shutze's most significant designs. The winners are expected to attend or send a representative. The winning entries will be displayed on the Southeast ICA&CA website.

### **Submission Requirements:**

Each entry should be submitted in a 3-ring binder with end pockets. The entry form should be enclosed in an unsealed envelope and inserted in the front binder pocket. Nothing should be added to the binder that identifies the firm or individual making the submission. Binders should include a prepaid return envelope so the materials can be returned. The \$100 submission fee should be paid on line at <https://www.123signup.com/register?id=mytcv>.

The binder should include a brief statement summarizing significant features of the project, site, landscape, and any details necessary to convey the significance of the project to the jury. Photographs of significant views along with plans and sections and brief captions should be included in the binder sufficient to explain the project to the jury. Similar explanatory information and images should be provided for interior design and craftsmanship. Also include a CD of electronic images at high resolution of 300 dpi at 8.5 x 11 for publication purposes.
